# CALL FOR SCHOLARLY PAPERS

November 24-26, 2006  
Vienna, Austria

Academics and teachers working in the field of multimedia and instructors in e-content creation will exchange their experience and knowledge and provide enlightening instruction for students.

The conference will be held in conjunction with the EUROPRIX Top Talent Festival, where the best young European content producers and multimedia designers will present their award winning projects.

### The conference program consists of:

- Scholarly paper presentation
- Panel discussions and workshops
- Presentations by selected instructors
- Address by key note speakers
- EUROPRIX Top Talent Award Gala

Paper competition: Presentations on scientific and educational topics related to the best practice of teaching and training for e-content creation and multimedia design.

### Publication:

Abstracts and conclusions from accepted scholarly papers will be published in the proceedings which will be available at the meeting. Web copies will also be available.

After the meeting selected contributions will be published in the EUROPRIX Scholars Conference book series (editors: "Deutscher Universitätsverlag" or other renowned university press). Extended versions of the contributed

papers could potentially be published in special field journals.

### Important Dates:

- October 2, 2006** Submission deadline for papers  
**October 15, 2006** Notification of acceptance

### Paper Preparation Guidelines:

- \* The paper should be at most 12-15 pages doubled spaced.
- \* The abstract should address the following 5 points informally but clearly:
  1. Problem: What problem or project is tackled in the paper.
  2. Scope: How the problem/project is related to best practice
  3. Motivation: Where the problem arises, with whom etc.
  4. Difficulty: Why the problem cannot be solved trivially.
  5. Solution: What your solution is.

These criteria will be used by the coordinating committee to rank the papers.
